Since its incorporation into Seoul from Siheung-gun and Gwangju-gun, Gyeonggi-do in 1963, it was under the jurisdiction of Gangnam-gu, but was separated from Gangnam-gu in January 1988 and became independent as Seocho-gu.

Partnership Description	Puriever, in cooperation with Seocho-gu Office and Yongin City, is conducting pilot use of air purification filters inside and outside city bus vehicles. The installed air filter is a non-powered environmental cleaning fabric filter that removes particles harmful to the human body through several years of clinical data. This filter also collects fine dust emitted from other vehicles on the road. According to the results of the pilot use of air purification filters at Seocho-gu Office, the total amount of pollution removed by 149 village buses is equivalent to 8892 trees. In addition, the collected fine dust contributes to analysis and statistical data by providing the pollution data of the fine dust collected through the collection sensor installed outside the bus to the real-time control center.

Counterparty Description	A city located in the southeastern part of Gyeonggi-do. Currently, it is the third-largest city in Gyeonggi Province after Suwon and Goyang. As of August 1, 2016, an article reported that the population, including foreigners, exceeded 1 million. On September 1, 2017, thanks to the tremendous growth, it eventually surpassed 1 million in terms of resident registration population (excluding foreigners), becoming the fourth city in the country to surpass 1 million after Suwon, Changwon and Goyang, excluding metropolitan cities. As of the end of April 2019, when counting the population including foreigners, it overtaken Goyang City, with a population of over 1.66 million in Yongin City. Gyeonggi-do'No. 2'As of August 2020, it is the third city in Gyeonggi-do, behind 749 people in Goyang-si in the resident registration population. However, it is the 10th largest city in the national population, surpassing the population of Changwon City in Gyeongsangnam-do.

As WHO (World Health Organization) classifies fine dust as a first-class carcinogen, the danger of fine dust has emerged. Accordingly, people tend to reduce outdoor activities of the family unit and prefer indoor shopping and eating out activities. It is a concern of the people.

Accordingly, in a situation where the risk of fine dust cannot be overlooked, the purpose is to reduce through education on emergency and constant reduction measures for fine dust and management of high-concentration emergency reduction measures in accordance with the enactment of the Fine Dust Reduction and Management Act.

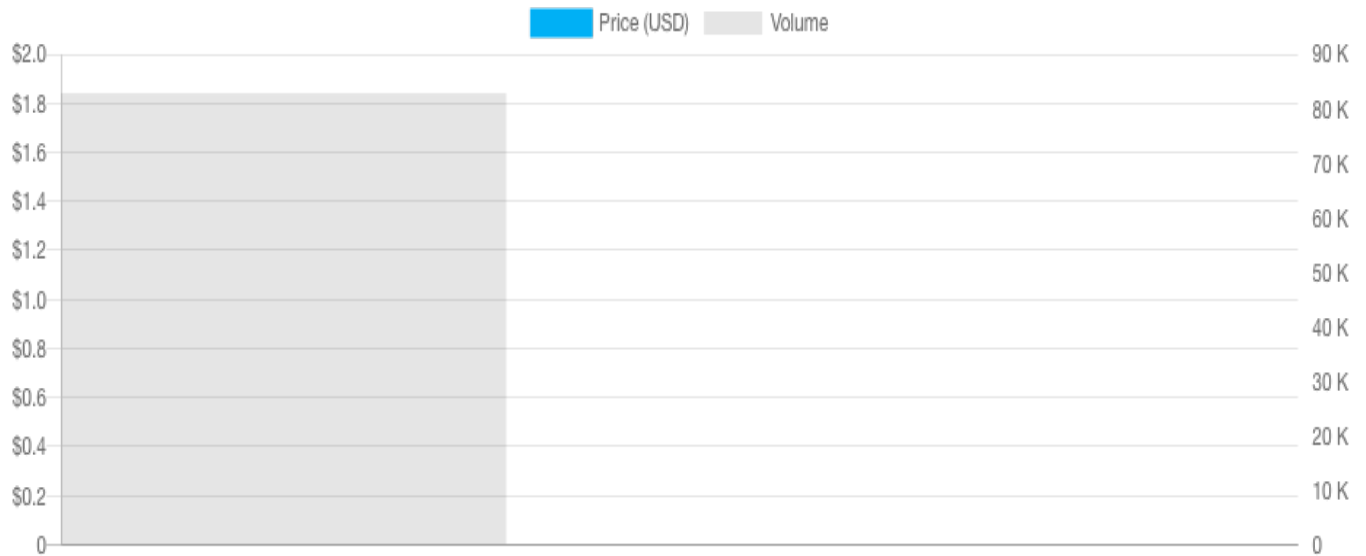

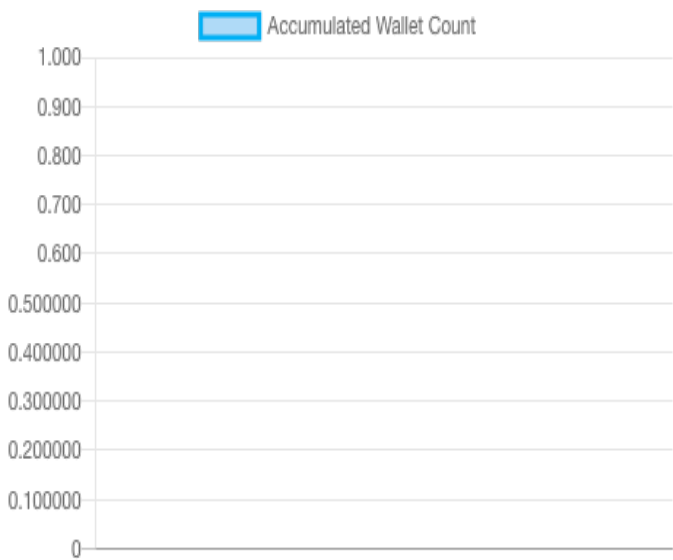

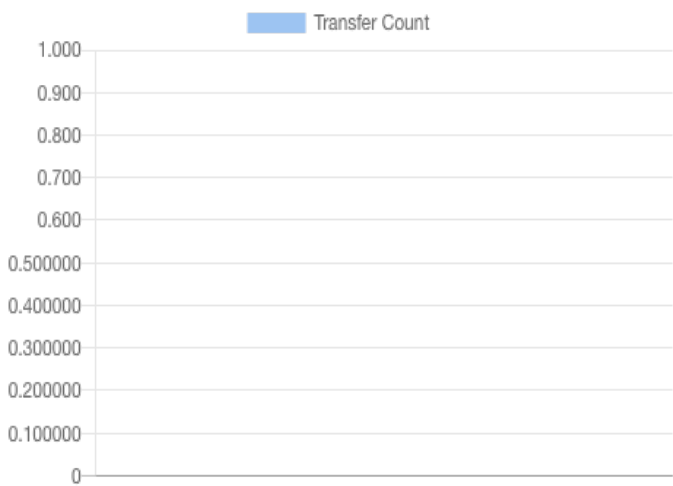

Accumulated Wallet Count



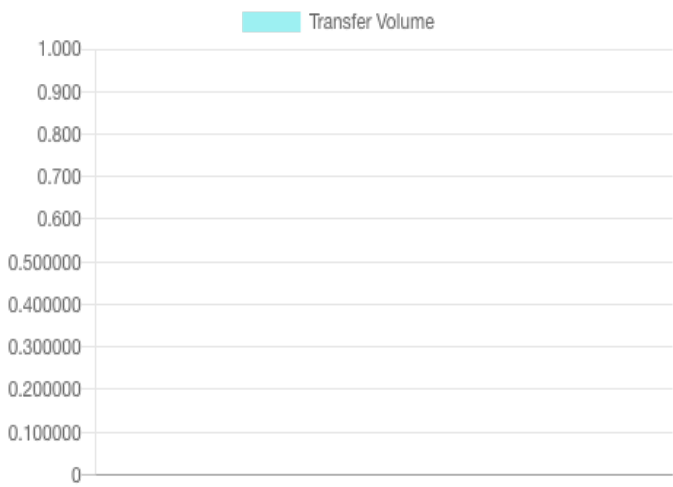
